Abstracts and Papers Submission

31 March 2008: Abstract submission to isaeuropeancongress@yahoo.it (see attached form)

15 April 2008: Notification to authors of paper acceptance and type of presentation (oral/poster)

15 May 2008: Deadline for submission of full papers (maximum of four pages, including tables and figures) to be included in the final conference program and on the proceedings CD-ROM (see attached form).

Abstract and full paper must be submitted only by e.mail to <u>isaeuropeancongress@yahoo.it</u> in a Word file attached to the message (file name "author's name.doc"; i.e., Smith.doc). The subject line of the message has to be specific (i.e., "abstract for the European Congress") to avoid spam filters.

No more than two papers per author will be accepted.

The Scientific Committee will select papers and determine the type of presentation (oral or poster) by 15 April, based on the author's preferences and the Congress's needs. Authors will be notified by e-mail.

Oral presentations must be no longer than 20/40 minutes, including 3-5 minutes for discussion and questions. Presentations must be in PowerPoint or Acrobat format. A computer will be available in each room.

Posters must be the standard size of 70 cm (width) x 100 cm (length).

Left margin 3.0 cm, right margin 2.5 cm, upper and lower margins 3.0 cm

File Type: Word for Windows

Tables and figures provided as graphics, with a resolution of at least 300 dpi

Font: Title: Times New Roman 12 - Bold. For the text: Times New Roman 11. For figures and

table captions, a smaller character can be used (Times New Roman 10)

The format to submit abstracts and papers is provided with this document.


The European Congress of Arboriculture will be held in Turin, which will be nominated "European City of the Tree" for the year 2008.
