Call for Student Posters

Students are invited to submit abstracts and prepare posters for the Ontario Urban Forest Conference near St. Catharines, Ontario, on Friday, November 5, 2010.

Venue: Four Points Sheridan Hotel near Brock University

GUIDELINES

- 1. Space is limited and may not allow for all submissions to be accepted. Abstract will be previewed for applicability of content, and must be relevant to the relationship between urban forests and human health.
- 2. Abstracts associated with the Posters will be published online and will be available to all OUFC 2010 participants.
- 3. Abstracts must be provided to Adrina Bardekjian Ambrosii (in MS Word ™ format) by September 15, 2010. Email to: info@adrina.ca.
- 4. Abstract content:
 - Title should be bold, at the top of the page followed by the Presenter name(s).
 - Presenter(s) contact details, including affiliation(s), should follow the title.
 - Text is to be typed single line spacing and should not exceed 300 words.
- 5. Each associated poster presentation must measure a maximum of 36 X 48 inches (91 X 102 cm). Each poster will occupy one-half of one side of a freestanding, poster display board. The poster board will accommodate pushpins and will be Velcro-receptive. Presenters will be responsible for supplying their own Velcro or pushpins for hanging their posters.
- 6. Poster content should include:
 - Title, author(s) name(s) and their affiliation(s).
 - Introduction, materials and methods, results, and discussion. Presenters should select a font and letter size to allow viewers to read the poster from a distance of 4 feet (1.2 meters) or more.
 - Posters will be on display during the conference and should carry your message without requiring any additional comment.
 - · Material presented must be based on the abstract previously submitted.
- 7. Set-up is to be completed the morning of Friday, November 5th, 2010, and will remain in place for the duration of the conference. During the lunch break, you will have an opportunity to field questions regarding your poster. Details regarding poster location and removal time will be announced at a later date. All posters must be removed following the conference. Posters remaining on site will not be retained or returned.

Abstracts must be submitted no later than September 15, 2010.
