Municipalities, landscape architects and developers are constantly evolving specifications for tree supply, planting and maintenance. Over the last few years changes to tree specifications have made a major impact on our industry, and the best way forward is to ensure that critical knowledge is shared.

Changes to tree production and planting specifications are the result of ongoing research into the complex life of urban trees. Many factors determine the potential for tree success or failure, and it is especially important to understand how the growing, planting and maintenance actions we apply now will affect the health and lifespan of our urban trees.

LANTA's "Tree Survival in the Urban Landscape" seminar will provide the most recent tree research information and challenge you to think differently about production, planting methods, and maintenance. You will also have an opportunity to discuss these new approaches to urban tree management during a round-table meeting at the conclusion of the seminar.
