Position Summary

Reporting to the Senior Technical Specialist, the Business Development and Technical Specialist is responsible for providing high-quality technical support to customers of BioForest in Saskatchewan, Alberta, and British Columbia. As the first point of contact for existing customers and new sales leads, the Business Development and Technical Specialist is responsible for the growth of BioForest's customer base.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide technical support to customers within the territory, including topics related to injection technology, insecticides, fungicides, other products as well as key pests and pathogens as they relate to management of the urban or commercial forest
- Develop and nurture relationships with current customers in an effort to retain and potentially increase sales within that group
- Develop and nurture the relationship with prospective BioForest customers, including potential service providers and end users such as municipalities, and work to convert these leads into new customers
- Develop new business for BioForest by attending trade shows, conferences, in-field demonstrations, following up on inquiries and other similar duties
- Organize workshops in the territory to showcase BioForest's pest management expertise and provide education on current urban and commercial forest health issues and innovations
- Perform presentations, demonstrations and conduct sales meetings with potential customers
- Assist in the development of training materials and deliver training to customers as required

- Assist in the development of marketing materials in coordination with the marketing manager, and review various marketing materials from time to time to ensure technical accuracy
- Develop technical documents to support customers
- Develop and improve processes and procedures related to technical support
- Develop and maintain advanced knowledge in pest management, both urban and commercial
- Monitor competitive technologies and develop recommendations for an appropriate response
- Provide feedback to R&D as well as the production manager on potential improvements or new opportunities (e.g. new products, new pests, new pathogens)
- Provide timely sales projections and other market related data to management as required
- Maintain high quality electronic and paper records
- Adhere to BioForest's customer service standards
- Adhere to Health and Safety Policy at all times
