As an Arborist, you will be responsible for office and technical field work related to the administration of Surrey's Tree Preservation By-law. This includes reviewing permits, applications, reports and legal documents related to single-family, multi-family, commercial and industrial development. You will be responsible for advanced level technical work.

Responsibilities include:

- Reviewing arborist's reports and tree cutting permits
- Reviewing landscape plans
- Calculating fees and securities required for tree cutting permits and landscape plans
- Working with planners and management
- Responding to inquiries
- Making recommendations and decisions regarding landscape related risk and design

You will demonstrate knowledge of OCP's, NCP's, BCLNA Landscape Standard, arboriculture, tree risk assessments, bylaws and landscape construction. You will have knowledge of software applications related to the work. You will also be required to understand and interpret reports, and be able to effectively write reports

The successful applicant will have the ability to work independently with limited supervision.
