DISCOVERY UNIVERSITY: STUDENT GUIDELINES

Guidelines:

Discovery University (DU) strives to provide a safe, positive, learner-centred and collaborative environment. With this in mind, the following list outlines what is expected of each student accepted into the DU program:

- 1. To read the assigned reading(s) before each class;
- 2. To attend the weekly class and discussion group regularly;
- 3. To be free of alcohol and street drugs when attending; and
- 4. To participate in group discussions, as follows:
 - a. treat each other with respect and compassion;
 - b. listen to each other
 - c. be reasonable in how long you talk, so that everyone will get an opportunity;
 - d. refrain from critical "put-downs" of others, and hateful or prejudiced speech;
 - e. accept that there will be many different points of view; and
 - f. do your part to encourage supportive and polite attitudes in the class.

Dismissal from DU:

- 1. Please note that students who miss three consecutive Friday classes will be dismissed from the program.
- 2. Please note that actions not respecting DU guidelines will be taken seriously and addressed in the following manner. Should a student disregard DU guidelines, the student will be:
 - a. given a verbal warning in the first instance;
 - b. issued a written warning in the second instance; and
 - c. dismissed from the program in the third instance.
- 3. In all cases, students will have an opportunity to discuss their situation with the program coordinator.
