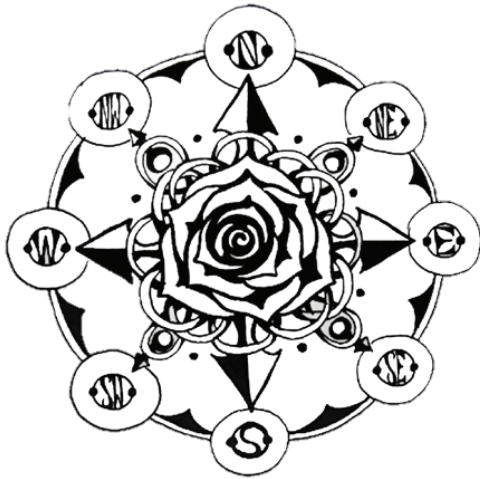


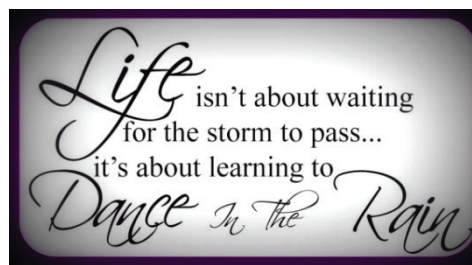
The time-honoured wind rose provided navigation support and guidance to mariners by calculating the average winds for each ocean for each month of the year. This information was used to create optimal sailing routes between ports.



The modern wind rose indicates the amount of time the wind blows from each direction during any given period. It can show how strong the winds are, and how often there are light breezes or, even, calm air.

If you would like to live at Windrose...

- ▶ Visit the Social Housing Registry of Ottawa in person or online at www.housingregistry.ca/site and complete an application.
- ▶ Select "Windrose, John Howard Society" from the list of supportive housing providers.
- ▶ Your application will be reviewed as vacancies arise, and if our program appears to match your needs, we will contact you to schedule a meeting and tour.



Windrose provides safe, stable and affordable long-term housing with on-site supports so that you can achieve your goals and maintain the positive changes you are working towards.
