Mobile Van Relief Staff (NESI Program)

Somerset West Community Health Centre is seeking applications for casual relief staff for the harm reduction mobile van.

Job responsibilities include providing needle exchange and safer inhalation supplies, along with support and health education, to high risk populations (i.e. sex trade workers, people who use drugs) to reduce the risk of transmission of HIV and Hepatitis C.

Services are provided using a harm reduction model.

Hours of work will be evenings and weekends on an on- call basis.

Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in Social Work or related health discipline or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Experience working with high risk populations and active drug users.
- Knowledge of and experience with a harm reduction approach.
- Sensitivity to people with differing values and belief systems.
- Valid driver's license.
- Fluency in English and French. Other languages an asset.
- Successful criminal reference check for the vulnerable sector
