On Saturday, June 7th, we'll be showcasing all the features that make 145 Clarence a great place to live.

We'll be giving guided tours of the building - focusing on the architecture, building accessibility, sustainability features and visiting the stunning garden on the podium deck. Come out and see how CCOC along with our community partners, create great quality affordable rental housing in the heart of the market.

Designed by Barry J. Hobin and Associate Architects, 145 Clarence opened its doors in 1993 with 84 units ranging from bachelors to 4 bedrooms, including 16 wheelchair accessible apartments. It is home to a mix of tenants: low and moderate income singles, seniors and families, as well as tenants with accessibility needs, supported by our community partner VHA Health & Home Support.
