What are the factors associated with the educational outcomes of children in care? An international systematic review

Findings from systematic reviews of interventions aiming to improve the academic achievements of children in care are inconclusive and call for a stronger evidence base. Factors associated with educational achievement are the genesis of interventions as they underlie the theory of change. This review aims to contribute to the field by critically reviewing the

literature to identify these factors and appraise the evidence their relationship to educational achievement of children in care.
