Eligibility Criteria for 2015-2016

The Dawn Rodger Family Bursary for the 2015-16 Management Certificate for Women (MCW) is now accepting applications. Dawn Rodger graduated from the MDPW in 2011 and soon after established the annual bursary for participants working in a non-profit, palliative care or social justice position. This bursary, valued at \$1,000, will be offered for each of the MCW programs graduating 2016 through to 2018. In establishing the award, Dawn said, "I am a firm believer in paying it forward." Her generosity will help to support other women who wish to participate in the Management Development Program for Women.

The **Management Certificate for Women (MCW)** is a part-time professional executive formatted program designed to provide working women with an opportunity to develop their management and leadership skills in a supportive environment, while having an opportunity to discuss the particular challenges that women face in management. The program meets for 2 consecutive days once per month for 7 months and covers all functional areas of business. The program is designed to facilitate the transfer of learning from the classroom to the workplace. Workplace based assignments require participants to integrate new theories and skills with data and experience drawn from their own work setting.
