Ray Sullivan is executive director of Centretown Citizens Ottawa Corporation, better known as CCOC. CCOC is a private non-profit landlord with over 1500 units at 53 properties in downtown Ottawa. As a tenant and volunteer directed organization, CCOC has a 41-year tradition of open and inclusive decision making. Ray has worked in the affordable housing sector since 1999.
