Position Description

JOB PURPOSE

Provides for the ongoing cleanliness of designated kitchen areas and assists in the operation of the kitchen requirements.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

- assisting in preparing meals as directed by the Cook
- cleaning the dining room, kitchen, prep area, storage room which includes the floor, tables, chairs, beverage area, mug and storage area and floors
- stocking shelves, sorting and unpacking food supplies
- maintains an adequate supply of clean trays, utensils, and dishes and ensuring available for use
- removing of garbage and cleaning of bins
- ensuring safe work practices are being followed (proper sanitary and food handling)
- ensuring policies and procedures are followed and adhering to health and safety rules and regulations
- performing other duties as required

PHYSICAL EFFORT/DEXTERITY REQUIRED

Requires a frequent amount of standing and moderate amounts of lifting (up to 20lbs), cutting, chopping, carrying supplies and walking
