- BETWEEN THE AGES OF 15-29
- LEGALLY ENTITLED TO WORK IN CANADA
- A CANADIAN CITIZEN, PERMANENT RESIDENT, OR GRANTED REFUGEE STATUS
- UNEMPLOYED AND NOT ATTENDING SCHOOL
- ABILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN 30 HOURS A WEEK OF IN-PERSON WORKSHOPS AND CERTIFICATIONS MONDAY - FRIDAY 9:00AM - 3:00PM
- NEED ASSISTANCE FINDING AND MAINTAINING EMPLOYMENT
- INTERESTED IN WORKING 28-35 HOURS PER WEEK

CANDIDATES MUST PRESENT VALID SIN CARD/PAPER AND VALID ID DURING INTAKE

4 WEEKS OF IN-HOUSE WORKSHOPS/TRAININGS

Participants will attend 30 hours per week of in-person workshops, trainings and certifications at Operation Come Home. Participants will also be provided with job search supports as the goal is to secure employment by the 5th week of the program.

12 WEEKS OF EMPLOYMENT

Staff will provide follow-along supports to both participants and employers for the first 12 weeks of employment. The goal is that participants are able to maintain employment without the support of staff.

NOTE: Method of program delivery dependent on COVID-19 restrictions. Program will run virtually if required (computer and internet access would be required).
