## **Nature and Scope**

Options Bytown is a non-profit organization founded on the belief that we all deserve a home. Since 1989, we have been providing permanent housing with wraparound supports to Ottawa residents who have experienced chronic homelessness. Our staff work with tenants and clients to foster caring and supportive communities, and the maintenance team are a key piece of that puzzle. Through supporting and improving the physical spaces that our tenants and clients call home, they lay the foundation for our networks of support. Reporting to the Manager of Operations, the Facilities Maintenance Technician is responsible for triaging and responding to maintenance requests from tenants, ensuring our buildings stay in good repair, and overseeing our inventory of tools and supplies. You will also be a key part of welcoming new tenants into our community through the cleaning and preparation of vacant units for occupancy.

#### **Main Responsibilities**

- Carries out maintenance duties as assigned by the Manager of Operations, and ensures that they are completed in a timely and professional manner

- Is responsible for responding to maintenance requests from tenants
- Performs quality drywall repairs, replacing/repairing toilets and other small plumbing projects, caulking, small electrical repairs, etc
- Ensures that the standards for maintenance response and repairs are met
- Prepares vacant units for rental under the supervision of the Manager of Operations
