- Multi-layered care we offer medication reconciliation and reviews with staff/clients AT THE HOME, medication training for ALL of your staff to optimize administration, referrals to other healthcare professionals, nurse visits as needed, incontinence supplies coordination, coordination with other service providers, sitting on Ethics Review Committees, frequent home visits, 24/7 after-hours service to answer ANY health-related questions you may have, etc.) – WELLNESS is our mission not just delivering medication

- Assigning a team dedicated ONLY to your homes/programs, which include pharmacists, addictions counsellors/outreach workers, assistants, etc.

 - When there is a medication shortage, we do not tell you about the problem and leave you to deal with it... We contact the doctor immediately to get an alternative or outsource to one of our satellite stores to attain the medication

 - Ex: NALOXONE Asthma inhaler education a pharmacist will visit your program and certify staff to administer inhalers so you can provide proper care to your loved ones

Staffing solutions for PSWs, UCPs, RPN's, etc. when needed at *preferred rates*:

We are affiliated with a placement agency that provides emergencies staffing/placement relief when needed if you are short-staffed

They can also be contacted if you need any particular nursing care that the Ontario government does not subsidize
