Since her appointment in January 2013, Suzanne has been the driving force behind MHI's growth and overall impact in the affordable housing sector, leading the organization through numerous significant milestones. Most recently, Suzanne led the organizations successful amalgamation with Gloucester Housing Corporation, which was formally completed on December 1, 2024. Her dedication, vision, and commitment to the advancement of affordable housing have left a lasting mark on both MHI and Ottawa's housing sector.

The Board of Directors at MHI have established a hiring committee and are preparing to launch a comprehensive search for the organization's next Executive Director. The selection process will prioritize strong leadership, a commitment to MHI's mission, and a deep understanding of the challenges and opportunities in Ottawa's housing sector.
