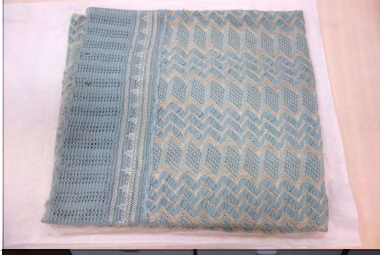

1978.036.001	Mat, table		Souvenir of Ypres showing the Cloth Hall, Les Halles. The base is pink satin surrounded by a white lace border. The outer 6 cm of the satin is machine embroidered with flowers in orange, yellow, cream and green. The center has a picture of Les Halles machine embroidered in grey and black, the names in white.	Some areas of the satin are abraded and torn. Edges of the lace are ragged.
1978.054.009	Cover, Cushion		Three items have been found with this object #. Original PP record: "Pillowcases, linen, 4 Irish linen pillowcases. Deaccessioned July 1987". Found two of these--embroidered with M in corners. Very yellowed and stained. The cushion cover is clearly not Irish linen, nor is it a pillowcase. Hand embroidered (satin stitch) leaves set in a drawn work grid. The embroidery is well executed, but the cushion cover seams have been poorly stitched.	Seams are coming apart. Stains
1979.027.001	Coverlet		A coverlet according to the donor. Very heavy for its size, the top has a border of light brown velveteen, the centre is needlepoint in a heavy wool (more like a rug), in pattern of flowers surrounded by scrolls on a faded red-violet background. The back is a beige satin. Padded internally with a cotton batting. A different red was substituted in one corner of the background.	Very fragile. Seam joining needlepoint to border has come apart. Very worn around the edges. Multiple rips, tears and worn areas. Backing is disintegrating. Most colours very faded.
1983.063.010	Bedsirt		Set of three white pieces, the end piece is cotton and the two sides linen. All have a lower fringe of heavy hand-knitted cotton lace.	Several holes and stains in the fabric. Holes in the knitted lace.
1984.803.001	Cover, Mattress		Finished edges with button holes every 19cm on 3 edges. Top edge has a machine embroidered applique floral design with no buttonholes. The original PP record states "Blue linen mattress cover" but I wonder if this could have been a cover buttoned on top of a comforter?	Soft and supple from use. Edges are worn. Some holes. A dressmaker could sew a lovely blouse or dress out of this!
1986.038.076	Rug		Rug, floral design, fringe, black, pink, blue and tan.	Slightly soiled- dark spot in bottom right corner.
