Thank you for taking the time to complete the Nova Scotia Youth Conservation Corps (NSYCC) Community Partner Project Proposal Application Form. Please submit your proposal **electronically** by **4:00 p.m.** on **Friday, April 6, 2012**.

The NSYCC partners with non-profit community organizations, colleges, universities, municipalities and other community groups to provide meaningful work experience in the environmental field for youth **age 17 to 30**. The NSYCC does not consider projects that are of direct economic benefit to a business or that involve work normally carried out by unionized employees.

The NSYCC seeks community partners who can offer work experience in one of the following focus areas:

- 1. Habitat conservation, restoration and enhancement
- 2. Education and awareness
- 3. Research
- 4. Air quality
- 5. Watershed quality
- 6. Waste management

Community partners may submit multiple applications for different projects. Organizations may request crews of between two and four youth to complete the project. The NSYCC contributes 75% of project labour costs, while the community partner is responsible for 25% of project labour costs and all other project costs. The NSYCC labour cost fee structure for the full summer program is as follows:
